

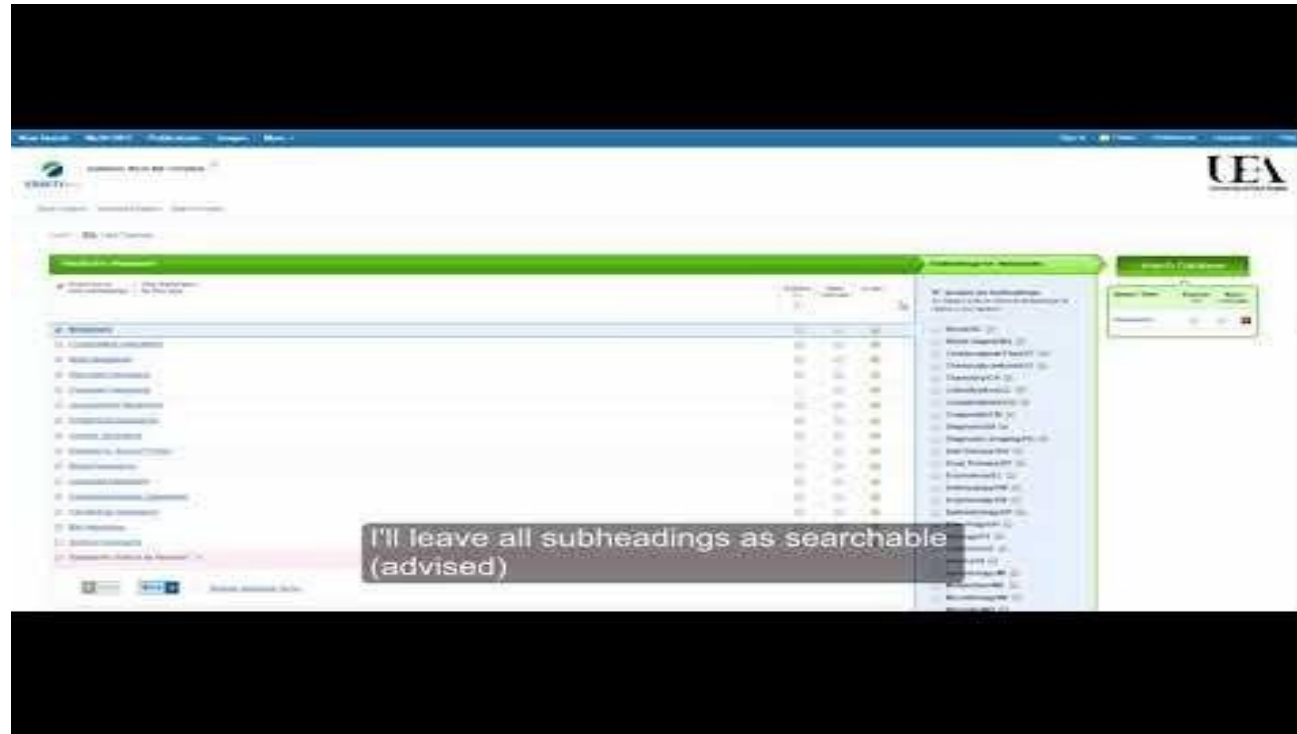

Tips and hints



You can expand your search outcomes and manipulate results by using these search rules:

1. **Searching for a phrase:** to find a set phrase, enter it into the search box surrounded by quotation marks.
2. **Boolean operators:** the available drop-down Boolean operators AND, OR, NOT are mandatory for Medline Complete. Perform set search with these. For example: AIDS **OR** HIV.
3. Save and share files in **Google Drive**
4. At any time, click on the **Help** link to view the complete online help system
